

In HCRS we have completed the SLO's for the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> semester LVN students and will complete Semester 2 Fall 2012. All of our students learning outcomes were met at 100% for this program. We will complete the SLO's for the Program in the Spring 2013 and anticipate passing rates exceeding the state average.

The Medical Assisting was recently revised and we will be completing SLO's on these courses and Program in the Spring 2013.

I am working with the 4 adjunct instructors on the SLO's for the Certified Nursing Program. We were conducting this process from the bottom up and have identified the ways of assessment, just need to receive actual data from instructors at this time. I have and will continue to encourage all adjunct instructors to attend the SLO workshop on November 3<sup>rd</sup> in an effort to reinforce the need for the SLO assessment, and the process for completing the assessments.

We have completed several courses in the Allied Health area and we have not identified any major problems or issues with the courses. We will continue to monitor and evaluate the courses frequently.

As a department our biggest problem is getting the data necessary for the SLO's from the adjunct instructors. Since many of our courses are taught solely by adjunct instructors, it is difficult to complete the SLO's. This is definitely an area that we need to develop a more efficient way to collect the data.
