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## **Mid-Year Progress**

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#### **Work on dual enrollment program with SSUSD Project Lead the Way (Engineering Technology program)**

Program has been through CIC but was kicked back from the state or district because of issues with mathematics. Dialogue with the high school needs to take place in order to proceed.

#### **Evaluate the C6 model welding program.**

The last cohort for the C6 program is currently in session. Some preliminary conclusions are being formed but final decisions will be made at the conclusion of the program when all the data can be analyzed.

#### **Maintain or increase the high number of certificate and degrees awarded in the Industrial Arts Department**

The new Industrial Technology Program is in CIC for final reading and is expected to run once it is approved at the state level and should bring in new students.

#### **Facilitate the opening of the new Electronics and Welding laboratories**

The transition for the old welding facilities to the new lab has taken place and although there are still some logistical issues to work out classes have started and there are five sections running.
