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Initiative 1: Promote The English for Transfer Degree

This is an ongoing goal, so that it will never be completed. The degree was promoted at the Desert Empire Fair. Since this is the first year of the degree, the 9 declared majors are the baseline for which we will measure the popularity of the degree.

Improve Success Rates in Basic Skills English Courses

CORs were revised. English 30 was reassessed in the Fall of 2015. Success rates were similar. English 30 has been discontinued. The assessment of Spring 2016 English 40 SLOs will occur over the Summer of 2016.

Increase Outreach to and Enrollment at New College Sites (Tehachapi, Mojave, and potentially, Cal City Prison)

Again, this is an ongoing goal as course offerings to the New College sites will hopefully continue to increase. Cal City Prison is now an actual site with English 70 offered in the Spring 2016, English 101 in Summer 2016, and Speech 101 and English 102 in Fall 2016. English offerings have also expanded at Tehachapi and Cal City, with English 70 offered at California City H.S. and Tehachapi in the Spring of 2016 and English 101 scheduled at both sites in the Fall of 2016.
