Year of Last Program Review:

2019 - 2020

Actions Taken in the Prior Year to Address Strategies:

Goal 1: Growth of the Honors Program - Sustain growth of the Program by mailings and informational sessions early in the semester. Counseling made presentations at the high school to recruit students into the Program.

One information workshop was conducted on Oct 4th 2023, and unlike previous years' practice, this workshop was opened to all students. In addition, Honors Program participated in college-centered outreach activities such as Cerro Coso Rocks to promote the program.

Goal 2: Consistent Pre-requisite - ENGL C101 has been the prerequisite for all honors classes. This is enforced at CIC when honors courses are submitted for revisions. However, with the Common Course Numbering Project (CCN) implemented by the California Community Colleges Chancellor Office, it is uncertain whether this prerequisite can now be enforced at this time. Clarifications with both the Honors Transfer Council of California and CCN Project have been sought.

Goal 3: Uniform and Appropriate Rigor - The requirement for a 2,500-word research paper (or equivalent) for all honors classes and contracts is continually being enforced. A member of the Honors Program Committee always reviews research projects in honors contracts before being approved.

Strategies Still to be Addressed:

Goal 1: Growth of the Honors Program - Current strategies will continue to be implemented. These include mailings, informational workshops, and college-centered outreach activities.

Goal 2: Consistent Pre-requisite - The prerequisite requirement for ENGL C101 for all honors classes is uncertain at this stage pending resolution and clarifications from HTCC and CCN Project.

Goal 3: Uniform and Appropriate Rigor -This remains unchanged. The requirement for a 2,500-word research paper (or equivalent) for all honors classes and contracts is continually being enforced. A member of the Honors Program Committee will review research projects in honors contracts before being approved.
